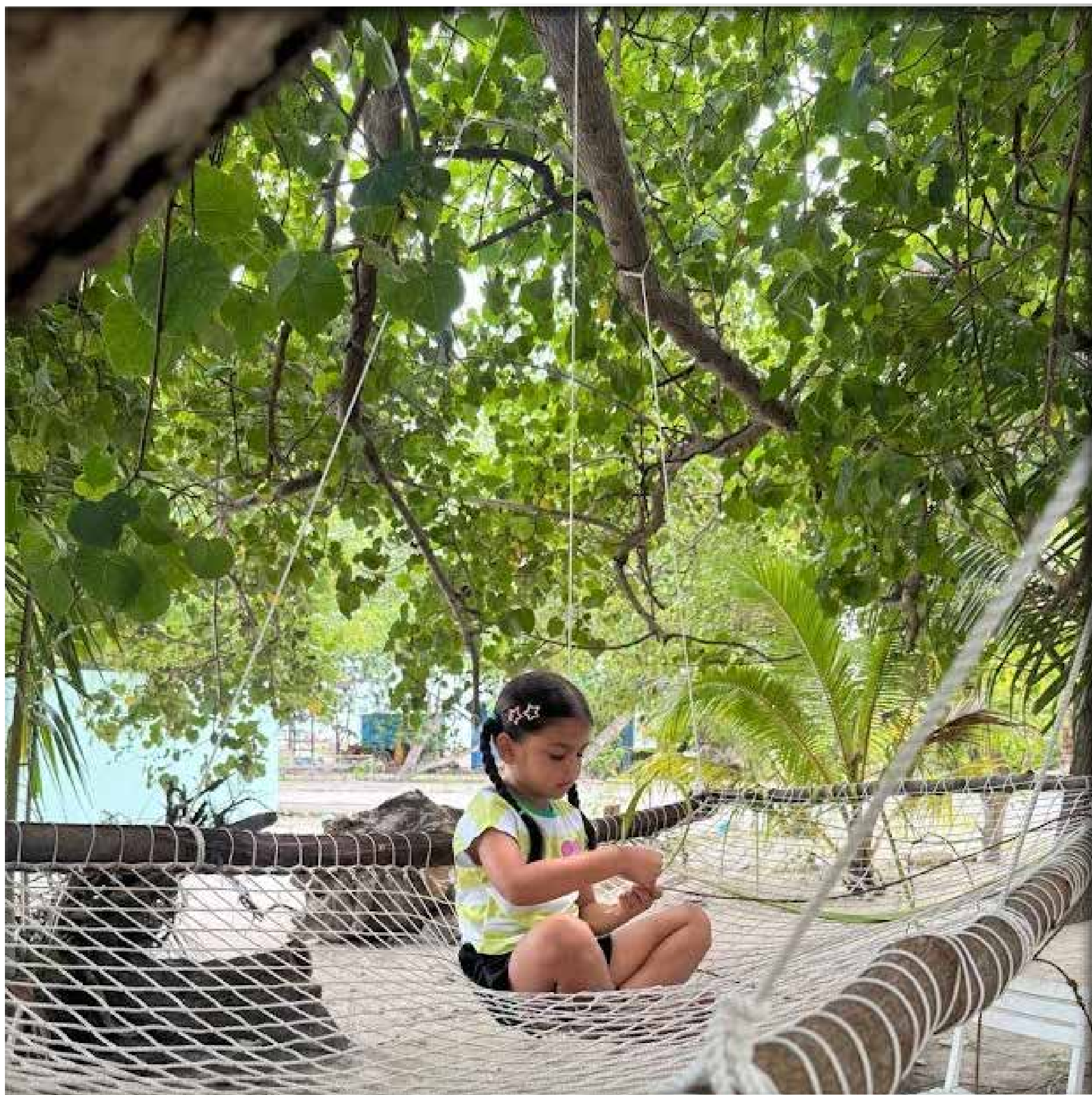

The Application Process

Step 1: Select Your Pathway

Explore our nature camps and select the track that aligns with your family's schedule

Step 2: Submit the Online Inquiry

Complete a brief digital intake form detailing your child's age, your preferred Nature camp and any specific accessibility or financial assistance requests.

Step 3: Admissions Review & Consultation

Our admissions team reviews your submission to ensure cohort balancing.

Step 4: Confirmation & Induction

Once cleared, you will receive a formal invitation package containing your enrollment confirmation, safety forms, access to parent space and a parent guide to prepare your child for nature camp.

How do you assist international families with local travel & hotel stays?

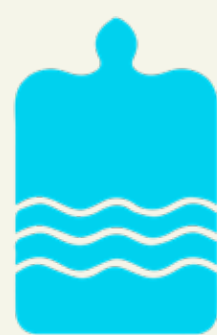
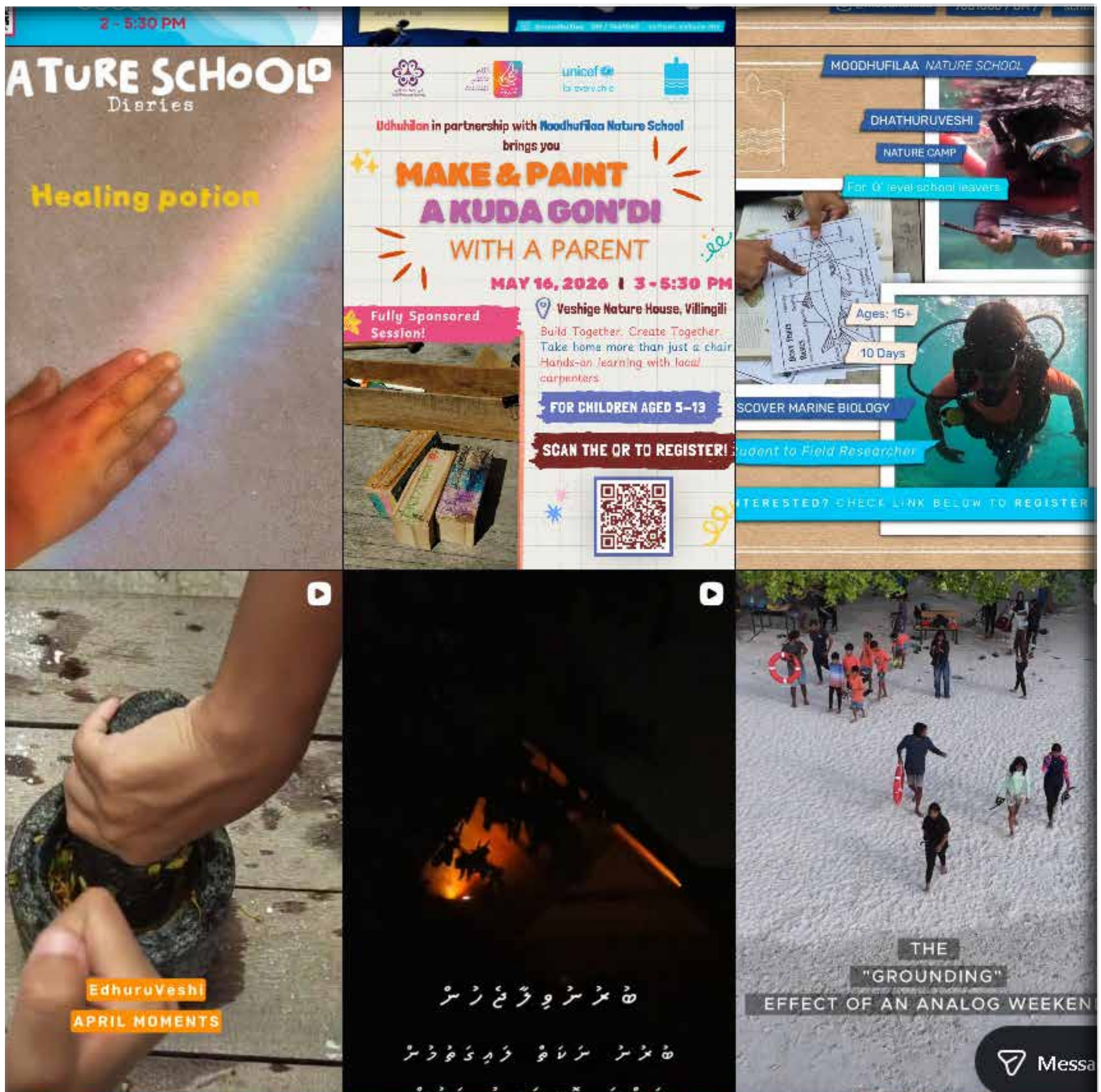

What do international travelers receive upon arrival?

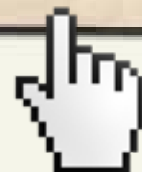

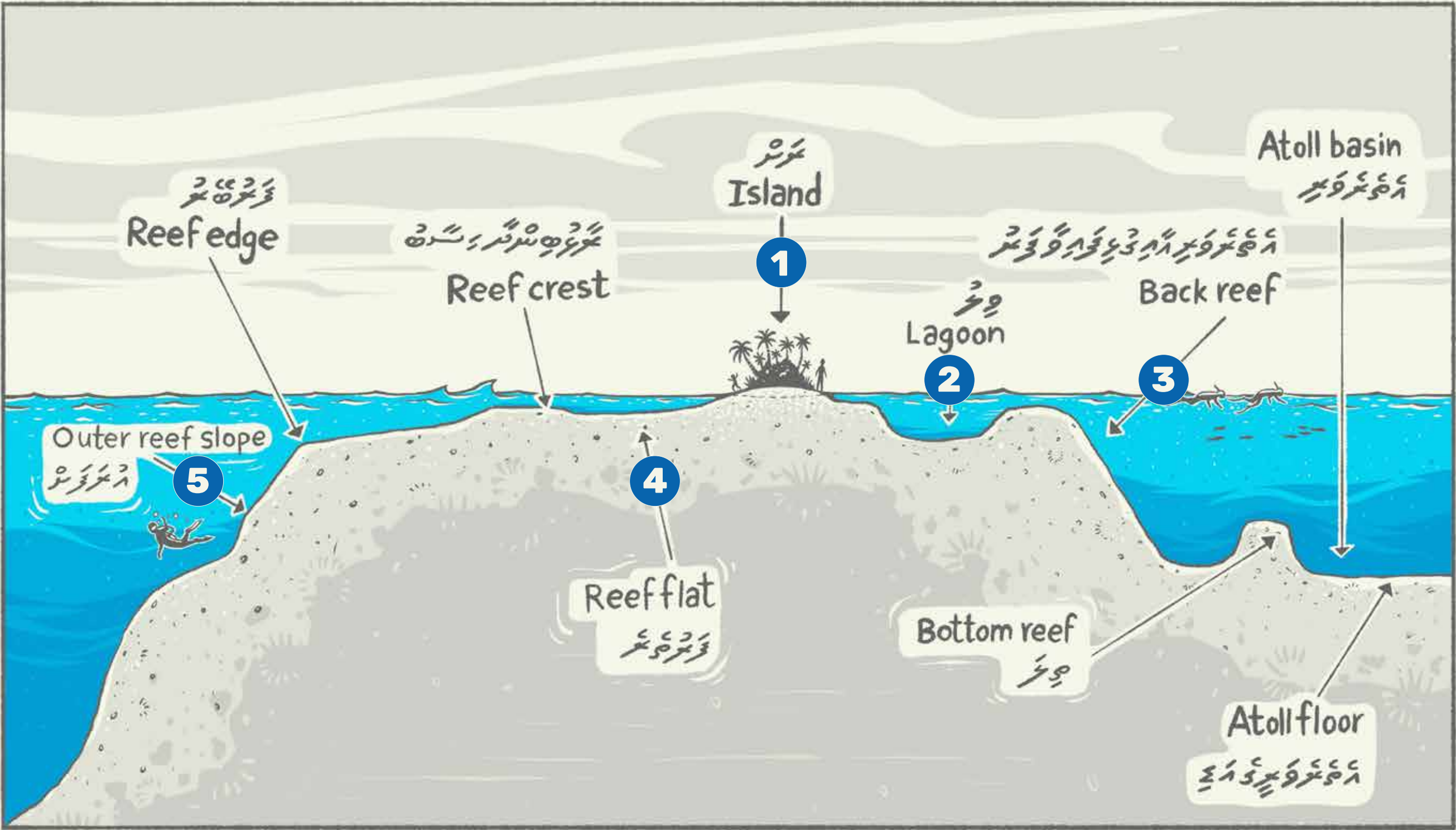

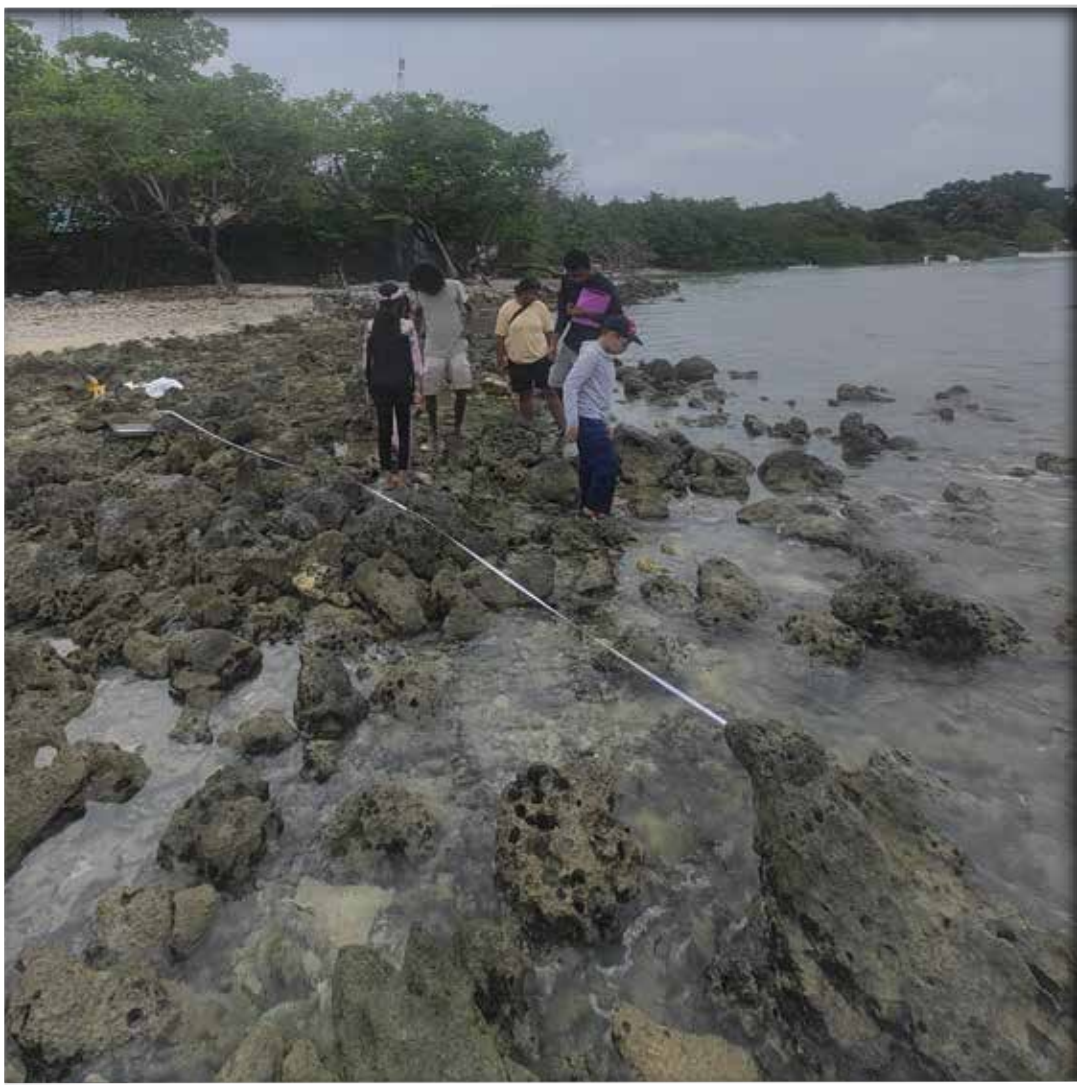

He loved to see all the wildlife, to learn the real names of the animals and to play with the other kids. He hasn't stopped talking about "nature school" and all the fun things he did.

Beneath the surface, we transform high school students into active field researchers. Using the Maldives as a living laboratory, this nature camp teaches ecology, chemistry, and geomorphology through total immersion. Students conduct field research across shorelines, and coral reefs, learning that SCUBA gear is a critical piece of scientific equipment for data collection.

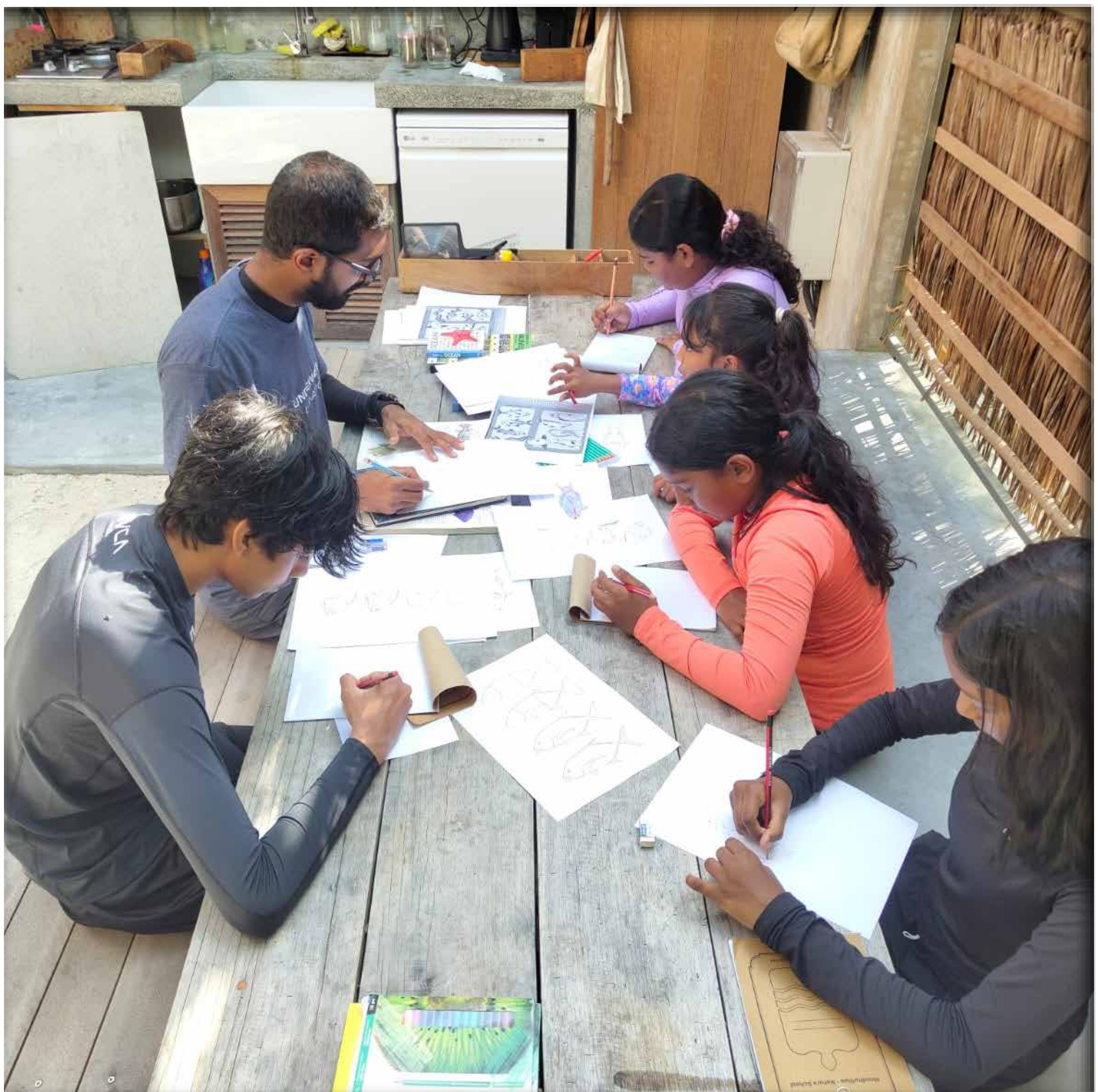
